I-35W Construction Project

The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) on June 1 began Phase 2 of the four-year-long I-35W construction project. Major disruptions will occur through September 2018. If you are traveling through the area, expect significant delays and plan to use alternate routes.

Aug. 3 - 10 Update

I-35W closed from Aug. 3-6

A second weekend closure of I-35W between Crosstown Hwy 62 and I-694 is scheduled to start at **9 p.m.**, **Friday**, **Aug. 3**. The roadway will reopen by 5 a.m., Monday, Aug. 6. The detour route is Hwy 62, Hwy 100 and I-694..

- I-35W@94 project crews will be working between I-94 and Crosstown Hwy 62 to demolish the 40th St. pedestrian bridge.
- <u>The I-35W Minneapolis to Roseville project</u> will be resurfacing the roadway between Fourth St. in Minneapolis and County Rd. C in Roseville.
- Hwy 280 will also be closed this weekend. Both directions of Hwy 280 will remain open to local traffic between University Ave. and Larpenteur Ave.

Bridge closure: Aug. 3

The 40th St. pedestrian bridge closes Friday, Aug. 3 and will remain closed through the fall of 2020. Bicyclists and pedestrians can use the paved trail on the east side of Martin Luther King Park, 42nd St. and 2nd Ave. S.
